W.W. Howells Book Award recipient and recent The Colbert Report guest, Dr. Nina G. Jablonski will discuss her groundbreaking research on the evolution of human skin. Her most recent book *Skin: A Natural History* reveals the significance for human health, our understanding of human variation, and our use of skin color to define unique human “races.”

Dr. Nina G. Jablonski is Professor and Head of the Department of Anthropology at the Pennsylvania State University. She is a Fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science and the California Academy of Sciences. Her research on human skin has been featured in National Geographic, Scientific American, and several PBS documentaries.
